

Celebrate Life is an anti-DWI program designed to achieve a goal of zero deaths and zero injuries from drunken driving in Green Island in the year 2013.

*Why Celebrate Life?*

- Because zero deaths and zero injuries from drunken driving is the only acceptable goal. Alcohol –related crashes are senseless, tragic and totally preventable.
- It is estimated that about 1200 people per day are driving in Albany County under the influence of alcohol.
- There is an opportunity for our youth from grades K-12 and others to play an active role in promoting safe and sober driving in our community.

*What will we do to make Celebrate Life happen?*

A grass roots coalition of village government, the school district and the community-at –large will work together to promote safe and sober driving throughout the community in 2013.

*How will the message of Celebrate Life be delivered in our community?*

- Safety messages at all Village Board , school board, faculty and PTO meetings.
- Daily school announcements and students holding safety signs outside of schools at dismissal time.
- Safety messages on envelopes used by the village and school district in mass mailings.
