The Village Office will be closed on Tuesday, July 4th, in observance of the holiday. PLEASE NOTE: The Department of Public Works will be closed on Monday, July 3rd. GARBAGE PICKUP on Tuesday, July 4th will remain as scheduled.

RECREATION NEWS

The Summer Park Program will officially begin on Monday, June 26th. The parents of any child wishing to use our facilities this summer will be required to fill out a program registration form. This will help our staff in an emergency situation when parents have to be notified. A registration form can be picked up and dropped off at the Paine Street Park or the Village Office during operating hours. PLEASE NOTE: that the Summer Park Program is not a registered daycare or structured program.

Save the dates for the following events happening this summer:

Bike Rodeo -Thursday, June 29th at 12:30 p.m. Please bring your bike and bike helmet to the park by 12:30 p.m.

Free Lunch Program - Free lunch will be provided daily at 11:00 a.m. starting July 3rd through August 18th.

The <u>Summer Concert Series</u> will begin Wednesday, July 5th, from 6:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m. There are **FREE** concerts every Wednesday through August 30th. The concerts are held in the Hudson River Park, just north of Heatly School. **RAIN LOCATION** is the east side of Hudson Avenue, under the bridge.

The <u>Sprinkler Pad</u> schedule will coincide with the summer program, which is scheduled to begin on Monday, June 26th – Thursday, August 31st. The hours of the summer program are 10:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. Weather permitting the sprinklers will be on Tuesday and Thursday evenings from 5:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m.

The **Albany County Department of Recreation** and the **Green Island Recreation Department** will sponsor a basketball camp for kids ages 6 – 14 at the Paine Street Park. The camp will be held on Saturdays, starting July 8th – August 19th. The camp is **FREE** for all Albany County residents. Please register at https://albanycounty.recdesk.com/Community/Home.

HELMET LAW

The law states that any child 14 years of age and younger must wear a helmet when riding bicycles. We also suggest helmets, elbow and kneepads and wrist guards when riding scooters, and skateboarders. Our police department will be on the lookout for violators, but more important they may even stop those that are wearing helmets to tell them "Good Job".

NEWS FROM CODE ENFORCEMENT

According to the Village Code, a homeowners must maintain grass and weed growth on their property. Failure to do so will result in legal action against that property owner. If the Building Inspector orders the owner to clean the property and the owner refuses, the Village will hold a public hearing. If the owner does not respond, the Village DPW will be directed to clean up the property and a hefty bill will be levied onto the property taxes. The Building

Inspector will conduct a survey and notify homeowners if they have buildings that are subject to this ruling. Please cooperate by making our community a more attractive place to reside.

REMINDER – DOGS AND POOPER SCOOPER LAW

It is illegal to bring any animal, with the exception of a guide or therapy dog, into any <u>public park</u>. <u>This includes all parks</u>, and the Little League and Veteran's Memorial Stadium. It is also illegal to allow your animal to defecate on any public or private property without picking up the mess, for obvious reasons, including the fact that if it washes into the storm drains it could go directly to the river, which would be a violation of the "Clean Water Act". If you wish to walk your dog, make sure you are prepared to clean up after them. We are also receiving complaints, and the Police have issued tickets to violators who allow or fail to secure their animals (dogs) from running at large. Please make sure dogs are secured in fenced areas or if out for a walk with a responsible owner/handler, make sure the dog is on a leash. Lastly, we have also heard complaints about dogs that are habitually barking. This is a violation of our Local Law. Violators are subject to fines.

RECREATIONAL AND OTHER BACKYARD FIRES

This time of year, residents like to have small backyard fires. Typically, it isn't an issue if residents keep a small manageable fire in a safe area of their property, and communicate with neighbors in a respectful manner.

If there is an issue, and when police and fire personnel are called, the NYS Fire Code is pretty clear that a fire is prohibited if the burning is "offensive or objectionable because of smoke or odor emissions.....". The Code also states that "Recreational fires shall be not be conducted within 25 feet of a structure or combustible material.....", and that "Portable outdoor fireplaces shall be used in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions and shall not be operated within 15' of a structure or combustible material." If our personnel are called, they will enforce the law, most likely making you extinguish the fire immediately and depending on the situation, cite you as well. Please be a good neighbor and don't allow yourself to be put in to that situation. Thank you for your cooperation. LANDLORDS, PLEASE SHARE THIS INFORMATION WITH YOUR TENANTS.

NEWS FROM TOWN OF GREEN ISLAND

The Town of Green Island is seeking individuals interested in running for elected office for the position of Town Justice. The Town Justice is an elected position which will be on the ballot in the 2023 General Election. Eligible candidates must be residents and eligible to vote in Green Island. All candidates should be prepared to serve the term of office which is 4-years beginning in January 2024. Town Justice is a part-time position. The position will require an understanding of NYS criminal, civil and vehicle and traffic law, rules and procedure. Candidates with relevant work experience and legal practice in related fields are strongly encouraged to apply. Training for the position is mandatory.
