

25 TIBBITS AVENUE, LLC PROJECT NARRATIVE

The attached application for financial assistance from the Village of Green Island Industrial Development Agency is intended to support the efforts of the Applicant in the development of an approximately 11.71-acre parcel located at 147 Cannon Street in the Village of Green Island at a total anticipated project cost of \$20,000,000.00. The plans call for two Class A Industrial Warehouses.

The proposed development will consist of the construction of two speculative commercial distribution/warehousing buildings as follows:

- Building #1 consisting of 120,000 square feet of space
- Building #2 consisting of 30,000 square feet of space

The project will require that the current 7 structures on site be removed. These buildings are abandoned.

The proposed development will cure an underutilized parcel within the Village of Green Island that has been vacant for a number of years, bringing new businesses and jobs to the area. The redevelopment of this lot will remove abandoned buildings and redevelop the lot into a thriving complex with 2 warehouse/industrial/distribution spaces.

Following completion of this project, the new business(s) will have a positive impact on the local economy. Restaurants, grocers, and local retail will all experience an economic upturn with the increased number of jobs the proposed development plans to bring to the area. During construction, there will be approximately 70 new skilled and semi-skilled laborers working on the project over the next 18months to 2 years. Following we estimate 40 new permanent employment jobs for the TBD tenants of the proposed warehouse spaces.

The employment types brought to the area will be consistent with typical warehouse/industrial spaces. There will be a handful of managerial/administrative, skilled machinists and trade workers, in addition to semi-skilled operational laborers. Labor rates will vary amongst these job skills, with all employees making over \$40,000/year in addition to benefits.

If the Agency does support this project, it will give the applicant a more secure financial base to provide the infrastructure improvements needed to redevelop that parcel of land and also support building warehouses that meet our luxury/class A brand. Together, this will entice businesses into a location within the Village that has previously been underutilized.
